1. **300 Games** MAXIMUM points in each category applies to the below CATEGORIES
MEN
 1970's = 3 pt ea. 1980's = 2 pt ea. 1990's = 1 pt ea. 2000's = 1 pt ea. 11-in-a-Row (one game) = 1 pt.
WOMEN
 1970's = 5 pt ea. 1980's = 3 pt ea. 1990's = 2 pt ea. 2000's = 1 pt ea. 11-in-a-Row (one game) = 1 pt.
2. **800 Series**
MEN 800
 1970's = 4 pt ea. 1980's = 2 pt ea. 1990's = 1 pt ea. 2000's = 1 pt ea.
 Any male bowler with an 850 or above = 6 pt
WOMEN 800
 Any women bowling an 800 will receive 4 points for each 800 bowled
 850 AND ABOVE = 6 pt
3. **299 Games**
MEN 1970 through 1999 = 2 pt 2000 – Current: 1 pt.
WOMEN 1970 through 1999 = 3 pt 2000 – Current: 3 pts.

 Any Man or Women bowling 800 series in the County tournament 4 pt
 Any Women bowling a 700 in the County tournament 2 pt
5. **SENIORS 60+**
MEN and WOMEN including Senior Division
6. **Southwest Florida Allstar Winner = 6 pt Southwest Florida Tournament Titles - Scratch & Handicap titles**
 All Events = 4 pt Singles = 3 pt Doubles = 2 pt Team = 1 pt

 1st place = 2 pt High Average = 2 pt High Game = 2 pt High Series = 1 pt
